Reveal Your glory to the kings, rulers and governors of the earth. Disclose the truth of Your supremacy and mastery in and over all things. Grant opportunities for our leaders to hear Your word clearly, as if it were spoken directly from Your mouth. Instruct them in Your ways of wisdom. Move them to honor You with public praise and to allow Your people to sing in celebration of Your ways.

You who seek God, let your heart revive. For the LORD hears the needy, and does not despise His who are prisoners. — Psalm 69:32-33 (NASB)

That people in jails and prisons will hear the gospel and follow Christ; for fellowships of believers to multiply; that they be protected from violence and forces of spiritual evil; that the spouses and children of prisoners would be sustained, protected, provided for and honored rightly; that released prisoners find strength and wisdom to live abundant lives.

PRAYERWALK: *Pray near a correctional facility or jail. Or pray near homes of those you might know who have a family member in prison.*
